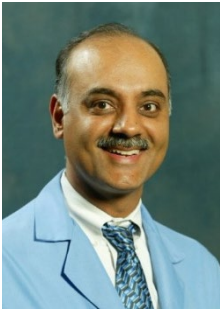


Kevin Deuschle

Mr. Brennan earned both his Bachelor of Arts and Juris Doctorate Degrees at De Paul University. He has practiced law in Illinois and has litigated numerous cases reported by the Illinois Appellate Court, the Illinois Supreme Court and the U.S. Supreme Court. From 1991 through 2013, Mr. Brennan was engaged in a private law practice, with an emphasis on Workers' Compensation. Previously, he served as an Illinois Assistant Attorney General, from 1977 through 1991, where he prosecuted Civil Revenue and Criminal Medicaid Fraud cases, before becoming the Chief of the then Industrial Commission Division.

He was among the principal authors of Larson's Illinois Workers' Compensation Handbook and published numerous articles dealing with Illinois Workers' Compensation issues for Quinlan's, Thomson West and Reuters.
